Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible

So many of us are curious about the Bible but get bogged down by the long stretches that do not make sense or get lost among the Old Testament names and places.

We are starting a very informal Bible study from Ascension Press called Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible. It is an eight-part Bible study, that will help us uncover the story woven throughout Scripture, so we can get the “big picture” of the Bible and understand what it’s all about. Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible will help you pick up the Bible with confidence and understand how you fit into God’s plan.

The plan is to meet weekly to view a 30-minute video presentation, then we discuss the video. Our Bible study will begin on June 11 after Mass. This Bible study is for everyone—folks who have studied the Bible, folks who don’t know where they last set it down or haven’t unpacked it from the last move, and everyone in between. This is for those of us who love getting together and talking about our shared faith, and those of us who are shy and wouldn’t know how to talk about our thoughts without a script. There is no pressure to speak, there is no homework. Just show up! All are welcome!
