PREFACE

The Ignatius Pew Missal is an annual subscription-based worship aid intended for Roman Catholic parishes. Its purpose is simple: to provide worshipers with a liturgical resource that is consistent with the directives of the Church and accessible to the average parishioner, especially in regards to music. This is done in two ways: by using simple plainsong melodies for the Entrance and Communion antiphons, so that a cantor, choir, and even a congregation can easily sing them, and by selecting hymns and songs which, combined, provide a repertoire of sacred songs that is fitting for the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, yet accessible for the average parish. We hope you find this liturgical resource useful. May it lead your parishioners into a closer encounter with the Almighty during the Sacred Liturgy, and in their daily lives.

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
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LITURGICAL YEARS

The texts found in the *Ignatius Pew Missal: Propers Edition* are sourced primary from three liturgical books: the *Roman Missal, Third Edition*, the *Lectionary for Masses for Use in the Dioceses of the United States of America* ("Lectionary"), and the *Revised Grail Psalter*. The Entrance and Communion antiphons as well as various antiphons for special days (such as the various antiphons for the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord and Ash Wednesday) come from the *Roman Missal*. The responsorial psalms and gospel acclamations in this book come from the Lectionary. Most of the verses which accompany many of the Roman Missal's antiphons come from the *Revised Grail Psalter*.

The Sunday portion of the Lectionary is organized into a three-year cycle, whereas the Roman Missal runs on a one-year cycle. Because of this, for many Sundays throughtout the liturgical year, multiple responsorial psalms and gospel acclamations (usually three) are provided. In each responsorial psalm heading is a bracketed letter, which indicates the year it is assigned to.

The liturgical years assigned to each secular year is outlined on the table to the left. Note that each liturgical year begins on the First Sunday of Advent (late November/ early December).

* The liturgical year begins on First Sunday of Advent, which occurs in late November or early December.

CHANTING THE APPOINTED PSALMS OF ANTIPHONS

As time allows, it is praiseworthy — though not required — to chant selected verses of the appointed psalm of the Entrance and Communion Antiphons. The use of these psalm verses, however, is always optional.

There are a number of possibilities for using verses of the appointed psalm:

1. The Antiphon may be sung alone without any psalm verses.

2. The Antiphon may be repeated after each psalm verse, or group of verses.

3. The Antiphon may be sung at the beginning and conclusion of the selected psalm verses, without any intervening repetition.


4. The Glory be to the Father may be included before the final repetition of the Antiphon.

5. Psalm verses are provided set to both Latin and English psalm tones. These psalm settings may be used with any of the four possible settings of the Antiphons, as may be determined best for any given situation.

At the Entrance, care should be taken to end the chanting when the Celebrant arrives at the chair. In the same way, the Mass should not be delayed at the Offertory or Communion. The chanting may cover the sacred action, but should not prolong it unduly.


INTERMEDIATE CHORDS

Occasionally in the harmonzation of the psalm verses, musicians will notice a chord in the middle of a measure that is not attached to a particular word (see image on right). These are called *intermediate chords* and are used sometimes. The organist will take care to play this chord on the penultimate accent of the phrase. (e.g.: guide me in your <u>truth</u> and teach me.)










During the transfer of the Most Blessed Sacrament, the Pange Lingua (#H649), with the exception of the final two stanzas, is sung. Once the Priest reaches the place of repose, last two stanzas of the Pange Lingua (Tantum Ergo, etc.), or another appropriate Eucharistic chant is sung.


The Priest and, if present, the Deacon, approach the altar in silence, and after reverencing the altar, prostrate themselves or, if appropriate, kneel and pray in silence for some time. All others kneel. Afterwards, the Priest goes to his chair and, facing the people, says one of the prescribed prayers.



VENERATION OF THE CROSS

The Deacon, accompanied by ministers, or another suitable minister goes to the sacristy, from which, in procession, accompanied by two ministers with lighted candles, he carries the Cross, covered with a violet veil, through the church to the middle of the sanctuary.

The Priest, standing before the altar and facing the people, receives the Cross, uncovers a little of its upper part and elevates it while beginning the Ecce lignum Crucis (Behold the wood of the Cross). He is assisted in singing by the Deacon or, if need be, by the choir. All respond, Come, let us adore. At the end of the singing, all kneel and for a brief moment adore in silence while the Priest stands and holds the Cross raised.

PRIEST/DEACON:

The Ecce Lignum Crucis (Behold the wood of the Cross) *is to be sung three times by the Priest/ Deacon. Traditionally, it is sung a whole tone higher each time, as in the Alleluia after the Epistle at the Easter Vigil (see p. 216).*

The ministers then carry the cross to the entrance of the sanctuary. The Priest Celebrant approaches the cross and reverences the Cross first, with shoes removed (if appropriate). Then the clergy, the lay ministers, and the faithful approach, moving as if in procession, and showing reverence to the Cross by a simple genuflection or by some other sign appropriate to the usage of the region, for example, by kissing the Cross.





The Priest or Deacon brings the Blessed Sacrament from the place of repose to the altar, while all stand in silence. All join in the Lord's Prayer, and Holy Communion is distributed as usual. During Communion, Psalm 22 (21) or another appropriate chant may be sung.

The hymn, Sing my Tongue (#H663 in the Pew Missal:Ordinaries & Hymns) may be sung at this time.

HOLY SATURDAY-THE EASTER VIGIL

THE SOLEMN BEGINNING OF THE VIGIL OR LUCERNARIUM THE BLESSING OF THE FIRE AND PREPARATION OF THE CANDLE

A blazing fire is prepared in a suitable place outside the church. When the people are gathered there, the Priest approaches with the ministers, one of whom carries the paschal candle.

The Priest and faithful make the sign of the cross while the Priest says: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit and then he greets the assembled people in the usual way and briefly instructs them about the night vigil in these or similar words:

Dear brethren (brothers and sisters), on this most sacred night, in which our Lord Jesus Christ passed over from death to life, the Church calls upon her sons and daughters, scattered throughout the world, to come together to watch and pray. If we keep the memorial of the Lord's paschal solemnity in this way, listening to his word and celebrating his mysteries, then we shall have the sure hope of sharing his triumph over death and living with him in God.


Then the Priest blesses the fire, saying with hands extended:

Let us pray. O God, who through your Son bestowed upon the faithful the fire of your glory, sanctify # this new fire, we pray, and grant that, by these paschal celebrations, we may be so inflamed with heavenly desires, that with minds made pure we may attain festivities of unending splendor. Through Christ our Lord.

R.Amen.

The Priest cuts a cross into the candle with a stylus. Then he makes the Greek letter Alpha above the cross, the letter Omega below, and the four numerals of the current year between the arms of the cross, saying meanwhile:

- 1. Christ yesterday and today
- 2. the Beginning and the End
- 3. the Alpha
- 4. and the Omega
- 5. All time belongs to him
- 6. and all the ages
- 7. To him be glory and power
- 8. through every age and for ever. Amen.



When the cutting of the cross and of the other signs has been completed, the Priest may insert five grains of incense into the candle in the form of a cross, meanwhile saying:

PROCESSION

When the candle has been lit, one of the ministers takes burning coals from the fire and places them in the thurible, and the Priest puts incense into it in the usual way. The Deacon or, if there is no Deacon, another suitable minister, takes the paschal candle and a procession forms. The thurifer with the smoking thurible precedes the Deacon or other minister who carries the paschal candle. After them follows the Priest with the ministers and the people, all holding in their hands unlit candles.

At the door of the Church the Deacon sings (and the people respond):



The Priest lights his candle from the flame of the paschal candle. Then the Deacon moves forward to the middle of the church and, standing and raising up the candle, sings a second time:

V. The Light of Christ. R. Thanks be to God.

All light their candles from the flame of the paschal candle and continue in procession. When the Deacon arrives before the altar, he stands facing the people, raises up the candle and sings a third time:

V. The Light of Christ. R. Thanks be to God

Then the Deacon places the paschal candle on a large candlestand prepared next to the ambo or in the middle of the sanctuary, and lights are lit throughout the church, except for the altar candles. 202

THE EASTER PROCLAMATION (EXSULTET)

The Deacon, after incensing the book and the candle, proclaims the Easter Proclamation (Exsultet) at the ambo or at a lectern, with all standing and holding lighted candles in their hands. The Easter Proclamation may be made, in the absence of a Deacon, by the Priest himself or by another concelebrating Priest. If, however, because of necessity, a lay cantor sings the Proclamation, the words Therefore, dearest friends up to the end of the invitation are omitted, along with the greeting The Lord be with you.

Exult, let them exult, the hosts of heaven, let the trumpet of salvation sound aloud our mighty King's triumph! Be glad, let earth be glad, as glory floods her, ablaze with light from her eternal King, let all corners of the earth be glad, knowing an end to gloom and darkness. Rejoice, let Mother Church also rejoice, arrayed with the lightning of his glory, let this holy building shake with joy, filled with the mighty voices of the peoples.

The bracketed text below is only to be sung by a Deacon or Priest.

(Therefore, dearest friends, standing in the awesome glory of this holy light, invoke with me, I ask you, the mercy of God almighty, that he, who has been pleased to number me, though unworthy, among the Levites, may pour into me his light unshadowed, that I may sing this candle's perfect praises).

R. It is right and just.

It is truly right and just, with ardent love of mind and heart and with devoted service of our voice, to acclaim our God invisible, the almighty Father, and Jesus Christ, our Lord, his Son, his Only Begotten. Who for our sake paid Adam's debt to the eternal Father, and, pouring out his own dear Blood, wiped clean the record of our ancient sinfulness. These, then, are the feasts of Passover, in which is slain the Lamb, the one true Lamb, whose Blood anoints the doorposts of believers. This is the night, when once you led our forebears, Israel's children, from slavery in Egypt and made them pass dry-shod through the Red Sea. This is the night

that with a pillar of fire banished the darkness of sin. This is the night that even now, throughout the world, sets Christian believers apart from worldly vices and from the gloom of sin, leading them to grace and joining them to his holy ones. This is the night, when Christ broke the prison-bars of death and rose victorious from the underworld. Our birth would have been no gain, had we not been redeemed. O wonder of your humble care for us! O love, O charity beyond all telling, to ransom a slave you gave away your Son! O truly necessary sin of Adam, destroyed completely by the Death of Christ! O happy fault that earned so great, so glorious a Redeemer! O truly blessed night, worthy alone to know the time and hour when Christ rose from the underworld! This is the night of which it is written: The night shall be as bright as day, dazzling is the night for me, and full of gladness. The sanctifying power of this night dispels wickedness, washes faults away, restores innocence to the fallen, and joy to mourners, drives out hatred, fosters concord, and brings down the mighty. On this, your night of grace, O holy Father, accept this candle, a solemn offering, the work of bees and of your servants' hands, an evening sacrifice of praise, this gift from your most holy Church. But now we know the praises of this pillar, which glowing fire ignites for God's honor, a fire into many flames divided, yet never dimmed by sharing of its light, for it is fed by melting wax, drawn out by mother bees to build a torch so precious. O truly blessed night, when things of heaven are wed to those of earth, and divine to the human.

On this, your night of grace, O holy Father, accept this candle, a solemn offering, the work of bees and of your servants' hands, an evening sacrifice of praise, this gift from your most holy Church.

Therefore, O Lord, we pray you that this candle, hallowed to the honor of your name, may persevere undimmed, to overcome the darkness of this night. Receive it as a pleasing fragrance, and let it mingle with the lights of heaven. May this flame be found still burning by the Morning Star: the one Morning Star who never sets, Christ your Son, who, coming back from death's domain, has shed his peaceful light on humanity, and lives and reigns for ever and ever. R. Amen.



THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the Easter Vigil, nine readings are provided: seven from the Old Testament and two from the New (the Epistle and Gospel). All of these should be read whenever possible. In case of more serious pastoral circumstances, however, the number of readings from the Old Testament may be reduced. At least three readings should be read from the Old Testament and their respective responsorial psalms should be sung. The reading of chapter 14 of Exodus with its canticle may never be omitted.

The structure of this part of the Liturgy is as follows: A reader goes to the ambo and proclaims the reading. Afterwards, a psalmist or a cantor sings or says the Psalm with the people making the response. Then all rise, the Priest says, Let us pray and, after all have prayed for a while in silence, he says the prayer corresponding to the reading. In place of the responsorial psalm a period of sacred silence may be observed, in which case the pause after Let us pray is omitted.

THE BLESSING OF CANDLES AND THE PROCESSION


FIRST FORM: THE PROCESSION

1. At an appropriate hour, a gathering takes place at a smaller church or other suitable place other than inside the church to which the procession will go. The faithful hold in their hands unlighted candles.

2. The Priest, wearing white vestments as for Mass, approaches with the ministers. Instead of the chasuble, the Priest may wear a cope, which he leaves aside after the procession is over.

3. While the candles are being lit, the following antiphon or another appropriate chant is sung.

ANTIPHON



4. When the chant is concluded, the Priest, facing the people, says: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Then the Priest greets the people in the usual way, and next he gives an introductory address, encouraging the faithful to celebrate the rite of this feast day actively and consciously. He may use these or similar words:

Dear brethren (brothers and sisters), forty days have passed since we celebrated the joyful feast of the Nativity of the Lord. Today is the blessed day when Jesus was presented in the Temple by Mary and Joseph. Outwardly he was fulfilling the Law, but in reality he was coming to meet his believing people. Prompted by the Holy Spirit, Simeon and Anna came to the Temple. Enlightened by the same Spirit, they recognized the Lord and confessed him with exultation. So let us also, gathered together by the Holy Spirit, proceed to the house of God to encounter Christ. There we shall find him and recognize him in the breaking of the bread, until he comes again, revealed in glory.

5. After the address the Priest blesses the candles, saying, with hands extended:

Let us pray. O God, source and origin of all light, who on this day showed to the just man Simeon the Light for revelation to the Gentiles, we humbly ask that, in answer to your people's prayers, you may be pleased to sanctify with your blessing X these candles, which we are eager to carry in praise of your name, so that, treading the path of virtue, we may reach that light which never fails. Through Christ our Lord. **R. Amen.**



He sprinkles the candles with holy water without saying anything, and puts incense into the thurible for the procession.

6. Then the Priest receives from the Deacon or a minister the lighted candle prepared for him and the procession begins, with the Deacon announcing (or, if there is no Deacon, the Priest himself):



7. All carry lighted candles. As the procession moves forward, one or other of the antiphons that follow is sung, namely the antiphon A light for revelation with the canticle (below), or the antiphon Sion, adorn your bridal chamber or another appropriate chant.







8. As the procession enters the church, the Entrance Antiphon of the Mass is sung. When the Priest has arrived at the altar, he venerates it and, if appropriate, incenses it. Then he goes to the chair, where he takes off the cope, if he used it in the procession, and puts on a chasuble.

After the singing of the hymn Gloria in excelsis (Glory to God in the highest), he says the Collect as usual. The Mass continues in the usual manner.

SECOND FORM: THE SOLEMN ENTRANCE


9. Whenever a procession cannot take place, the faithful gather in church, holding candles in their hands. The Priest, wearing white sacred vestments as for Mass, together with the ministers and a representative group of the faithful, goes to a suitable place, either in front of the church door or inside the church itself, where at least a large part of the faithful can conveniently participate in the rite.

10. When the Priest reaches the place appointed for the blessing of the candles, candles are lit while the antiphon Behold, our Lord (see p. 594) or another appropriate chant is sung.

11. Then, after the greeting and address, the Priest blesses the candles, as above, and the the procession to the altar takes place, with singing (see pp. 596–598). For Mass, what is indicated in no. 8 above is observed.


